



AdventHealth Case Study

In February 2019, AdventHealth Connerton added 9 UVZone Shoe Sanitizing Stations to reduce the spread of harmful germs throughout their facility.

Between February 2019 and March 2020, the stations, in conjunction with existing infection control measures, decreased the microbial load in their facility, resulting in a **53% drop in Hospital Associated Infections (HAIs)**.
